"The revelation of Jesus Christ..."

Clarity is not the first word that comes to mind when most people think about the book of Revelation. Confusion, maybe. Bizarre. Intimidating. But the author of Revelation tells us that it was intended to "reveal" or to "make clear" who Jesus is. So this became our prayer as we headed to Michigan for Chapter Focus Week, a retreat with students from around the MidWest. Michelle was tasked with teaching Revelation 1-4 during the evening plenary sessions.

We decided to use the images of Revelation like a pair of 3D glasses - to see if they might help reveal Jesus more fully to us. And He was! After studying themes of love, of suffering, of self-sufficiency, and of Jesus' invitations, we saw 3 students become Christians, about 15 respond to a call of Lordship by confessing selfsufficiency, and about 200 ask Jesus to replace their shame with honor. There were also commitments to share the gospel more fully back on campus.

Eddy, one of the new Christians, shared, "All year long I had been trying to follow God, but He had felt like a stranger to me. But this week Jesus became real."
